

THEME 1: Closing the Disadvantaged Gap




The morning will be led by **FINOLA WILSON**, author of the recently published book on how best to support disadvantaged learners.

This new book is a **VISUAL WORKBOOK** full of practical steps schools can take looking at teaching pedagogy, monitoring, culture, language etc.

The morning will be all about practical strategies, exploring various themes as mini-WORKSHOPS promoting discussion, sharing of practice and interaction.

We hope by the end that schools will have specific themes they can take back to school and implement.

THEME 2: Increasing national accountability: what are RISE advisers all about and what can I learn from their work to date which will help my school?
